







## Varsity Lakes Middle School Uniform Dress Code 2011-2012

-  **Shirts:** Solid color, polo style collared shirts or Varsity Lakes t-shirts –
- Polo shirts must have a maximum of 3 buttons (not cap sleeve).
  - All shirts must be tucked in and fit appropriately.
  - A single brand logo (approximately the size of a quarter) may appear on the shirt's chest or sleeve area.
  - Students are only allowed to wear a **plain white** t-shirt/camisole underneath the polo shirt.
-  **-Pants/Shorts/Capri's/Skirts:** Acceptable colors –**Navy, Khaki, & Brown**
- All uniform bottoms must be a solid color listed above.
  - Uniform bottoms must be worn at the waist, above the hip/pelvic bone.
  - Uniform bottoms must fit appropriately (No tight pants).
  - All pants, skirts and shorts must have belt loops; length of skirts and shorts must be at or below the knee in the standing position.
  - **ALL ONE COLOR ATTIRE IS NOT ALLOWED. SHIRTS MUST BE A DIFFERENT COLOR FROM PANTS.**
- The following items may not be worn:**
- Jeans, Denim of any Color, Cargo shorts/pants, Carpenter pants Low rise bottoms, Hip hugger bottoms, Clothing that drags on the ground (ex. pant legs), Torn clothing, Extra zippers, Extra pockets, Ties and/or strings, Non-functional buttons, Ornamental stitching, Lycra, Spandex, Stretch fabrics, Corduroy, Ribbons, Ruffles, Bows, Slits on the pants legs and Tied waist bands.
-  **Belts:** Belts must worn at all times
- Belt buckles should not display names, logos, flags, or other emblems.
  - Belts must be plain, solid color, and unadorned (no studs or grommets).
  - Over-sized buckles are prohibited.
-  **Jackets/Sweaters:** Plain solid color
- Jackets/sweaters may be worn on cool days and must not be buttoned or zipped up. The jacket/sweater must be worn with a shirt that meets dress code requirements and cannot be tied around the waist. **Pullover sweaters, Pullover jackets, Pullover sweatshirts, and hooded sweatshirts/jackets are not allowed .**
-  **Footwear:** Closed toe shoes
- No sandal, slipper-type shoes or beach-type shoes, including shoes made out of mesh or plastic, and no "Croc" style shoes are allowed
  - Shoes, shoelaces, and socks must be the same color and worn appropriately.
-  **Misc.:** Bandanas, and lines/designs in eyebrows or hair, are not allowed
- Hats, caps, headgear, gloves and sunglasses are **NOT** permitted in the building. There may be exceptions for medical conditions (with a doctor's note) and/or physical education classes being held outside which permit sunglasses and hats. The administration will determine these exceptions.
  - Any necklace should be worn under the shirt

**\* ALL OTHER DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS ALREADY IN THE STUDENT HANDBOOK AND ALIGNED WITH THE LEE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT.**

**\*The principal and staff will designate special event days and provide the students with information on how the dress code may be altered for those days.**

**\*The acceptable style and colors are available at all major department/discount clothing stores.**

**\*All uniform dress code issues not addressed above will be subject to administrative discretion.**
