| School Compact | School Compact was presented and voted unanimously on for approval of the compact. |
| Parent Involvement | Events from the PFEP were presented to the committee. Events will be advertized on marquee, parentlinks, flyers, website. Events such as Donuts with Dad, and Muffins with Moms, Active Parenting Now, and others. Parents werre asked for input on additional events, but none were suggested at this time. |
| School Improvement | Dr. Mederios reviewed our Goal Setting Chart which was broken down by learning level, learning gains and subject. Varsity Lakes has a goal of raising their testing totals by 65 points, to strive for an "A" status school. ELA will increase from a 55 to a 60, Math will increase from a 64 to a 68, Science will increase from a 46 to a 60, and Social Studies will increase from a 71 to a 77. ELA Learning gains will increase from a 56 to a 65, Math learning gains will increase from a 64 to a 70, ELA L25 gains will increase from a 42 to a 53, and Math L25 gains will increase from a 47 to a 57. Dr. Mederios also discussed strategies that each subject will utilize to attain our goal. Dr. Mederios fielded questions from parents on grades and curriculum. |
