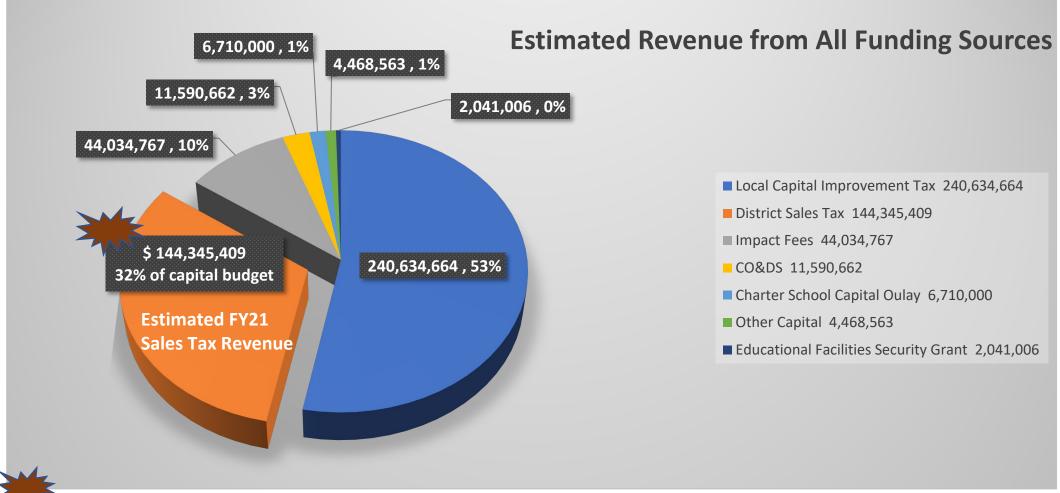

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## FY21 Capital Budget - \$453.8M

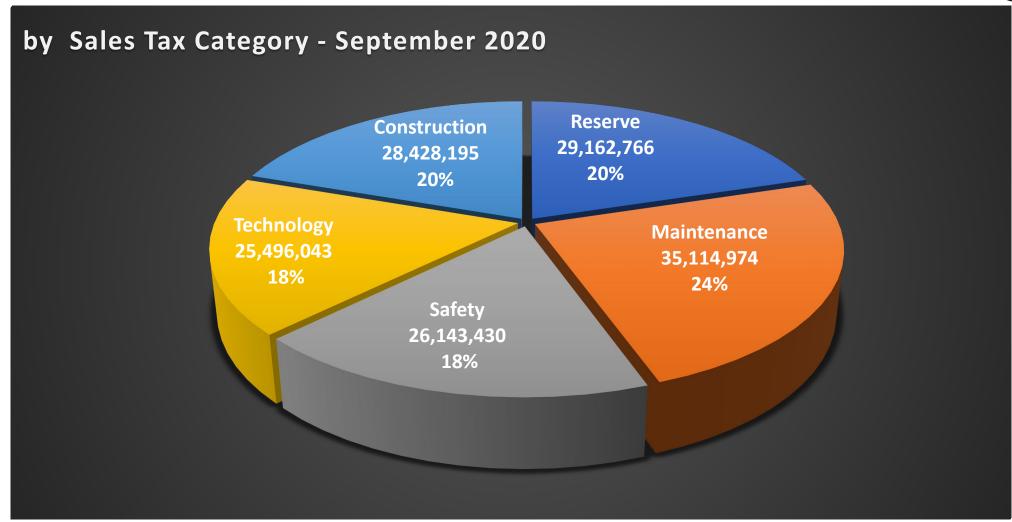




ISSOC focus - sales tax revenue & projects

#### **Categories of Projects**







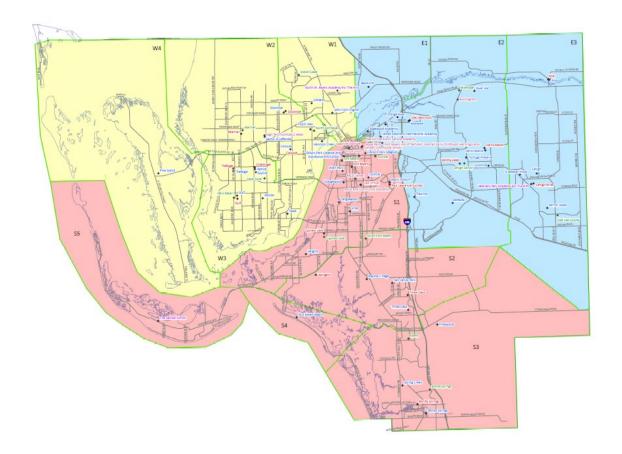

# Gateway High School – Project Update

- ✓ Scheduled to open August 2021
  - Adds 2139 student stations
- √ Total project cost: \$98,193,950
  - Guaranteed Maximum Price
  - Phase 1 Design completed on time within budget
  - Phase 2 Construction in progress
- ✓ FY21 Sales Tax Funds
  - Debt service \$12,039,939
  - Payments occur twice annually

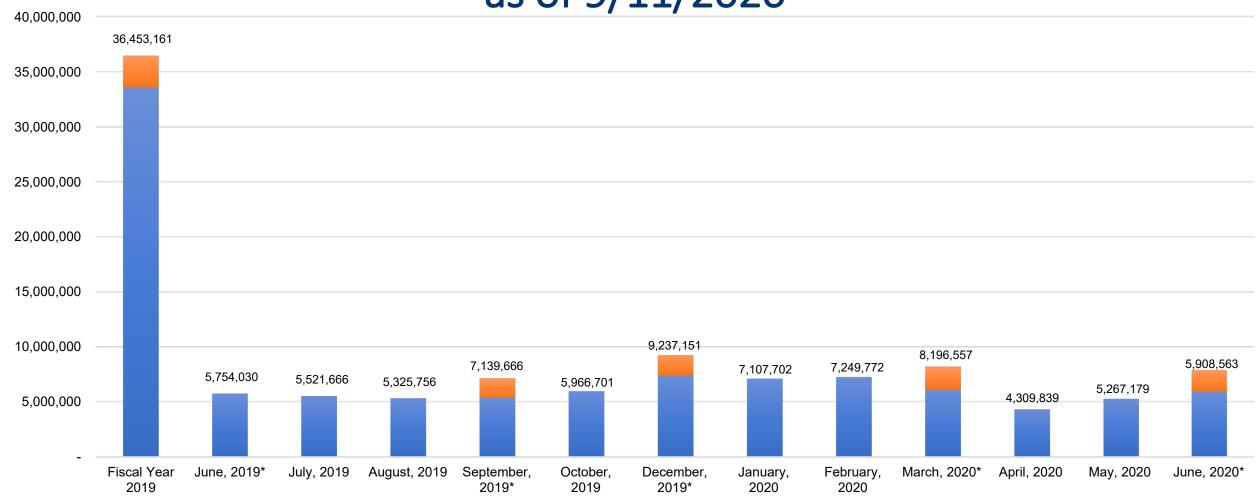

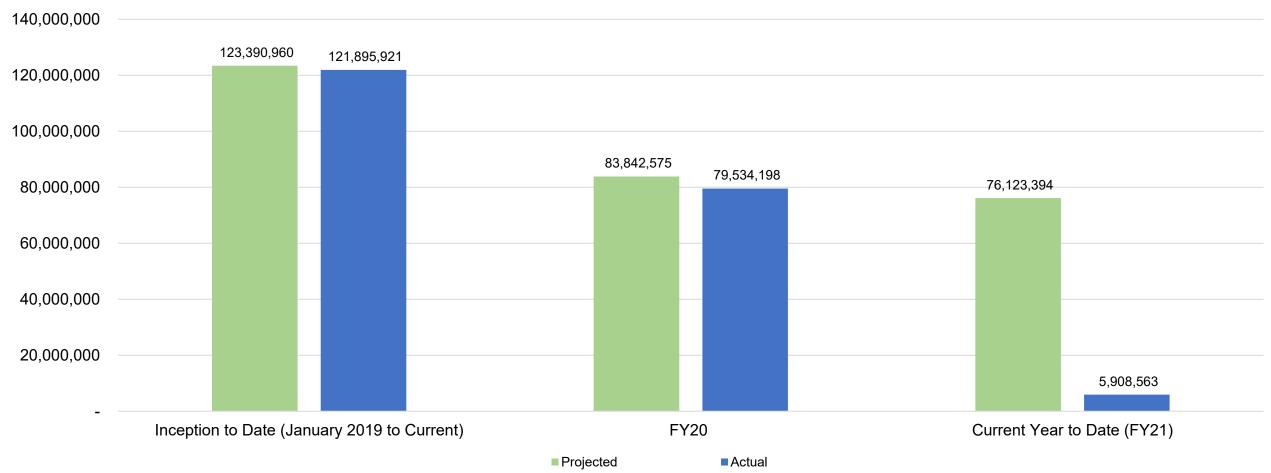

# Monthly Sales Tax Revenue by Month Earned as of 9/11/2020

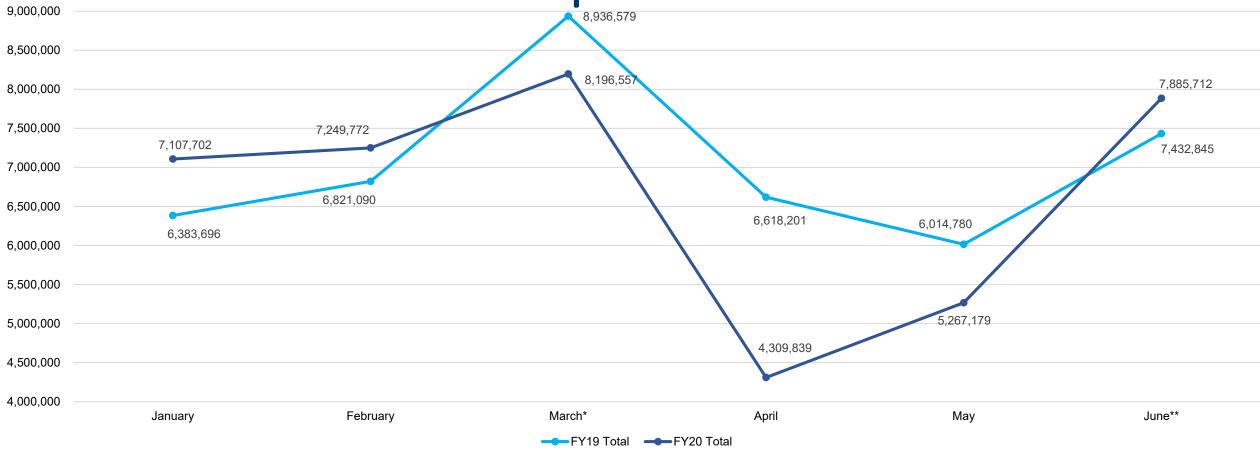


# Revenue – Projections vs. Actual Collections as of 9/11/2020



FY20 Projected is original projection. The revised projection due to COVID-19 was \$75,075,324; actual collections exceeded revised projection.

- Original projections were very conservative given the many unknowns with COVID-19.
- Projections were revised in early September to better align with state of economy and state-wide reports released by the Florida Department of Economic & Demographic Research (EDR).
- FY21 projection is \$3.4 million (or 4%) less than revenue received in FY20.
- Continue to wait for release of Local Government
   Financial Information Handbook from Florida EDR for
   their estimation of School Capital Outlay Surtax.
- Also continue to monitor local economic indicators through valuable reports produced by the FGCU's Regional Economic Research Institute.
