

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FY22 Capital Revenue - \$265.3M








FY22 Sales Tax Budget - \$159,868,811





- Currently considering site across from James Stephens. This site already has the infrastructure in place saving the District thousands of dollars.
- December 2022 projected scheduled completion of the portable campus. Students and staff will return to portable campus January 2023.
- January 2023 projected schedule to begin demolition of the school
- October 2023 anticipated start date of actual construction.

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Gutter Repair/Replacement – Edgewood Academy (Project Recently Completed)







KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- The school had no gutters/downspouts alongside the interior parts of the campus.
- With the new gutters and downspouts installed, the rain water is now re-directed to the corresponding collection regions instead of splashing onto student walkway areas.
- This will prevent washouts that can lead to trip hazards for staff and students.

- ▶ New gutters are anodized aluminum suitable for SW Florida climate.
- Gutters requiring replacement are rusted through and no longer redirect water flow properly.

(Ongoing Project – Chiller Upgrade Project at Island Coast HS)



Project Scope

- 2 Qty 440 ton Trane air cooled chillers are being installed.
- Perfect timing for this project. Last year's energy consumption revealed that the school utilized about 5.3 million kilowatt hours when compared to similar sites which utilized 3.5 million kilowatt hours.
- In dollars, this campus was approximately 58% higher in energy costs.

Restroom Upgrades (Ongoing Projects)

KEY HIGHLIGHTS


- At North Fort Myers HS, water leaks over the years have caused studs and track to rust behind the ceramic tile walls. To reinforce walls, partial wall sections have been installed. (Right picture, red arrow.)
- At Cypress Lake HS, gang restroom partitions, fixtures, lighting, etc. need to be upgraded to meet ADA compliance.


