Community Engagement

The School Board of Lee County believes that community engagement is essential to the District's commitment to student learning. The purpose of public engagement is to channel community concerns and issues into constructive action. Four principles of community engagement are:

- (1) Inclusiveness
- (2) Focus on efforts to increase learning
- (3) Building consensus around those efforts
- (4) Two-way communication

The Board demonstrates its commitment to public engagement in a variety of ways including establishing appropriate Board advisory committees, serving as liaisons to community groups, and creating alliances with business and other units of government.

School and District staff is expected to participate in community engagement efforts, including parent and community involvement in decision-making and communication efforts.
