Satisfactory Conduct to Participate in Athletics

The School Board of Lee County believes that students must maintain satisfactory conduct and meet all of the current requirements of the Florida High School Athletic Association to participate in extracurricular activities.

- (1) If the student is convicted of or is found to have committed a felony or a delinquent act which would have been a felony if committed by an adult, regardless of whether adjudication is withheld, the student's participation in interscholastic extracurricular activities shall cease for the remainder of that school year.
- (2) A report of an alleged violation of this standard of conduct shall be submitted to the principal or his/her designee for investigation. If the principal or their designee determines that a violation has occurred, the student and their parent/guardian shall be notified, in writing, of the suspension from school-sponsored extracurricular activities.
